TASTING NOTES: This powerful Rhone blend is big, bold, and stylistically California to its core. Dark fruit highlights this fantastic wine. It explodes with flavors of plum, black currant, raspberries, and blackberries. The vanilla tones from the French oak are intertwined beautifully. The tannins are bold but not overpowering and add a fantastic weight and texture to the wine. This wine will age for 10+ years.

VINATGE NOTES: A classic vintage. 2013 was a very temperate year with no unusual heat spikes or frost. Also, a dry and early harvest resulting in low yields and great overall quality.
